Salomon Maimon develops a new theory of reason (ground) and cause in the *principle of determinability*. Fichte uses Maimon's concept in his *Wissenschaftslehre* and influences the philosophy of German idealism. Johann Baptist Schad, an almost unknown philosopher at the beginning of the 19th century, is an example of the development of this concept. Hegel's *Logic of Essence* deals with this theory of reason in the transition from reflection to appearance.
