Maria Caterina Marinelli Maimon's Implicit Influence in the Eigne Meditationen über Elementar Philosophie of Fichte

This work intends to examine the implicit influence of Maimon in the *Eigne Meditationen über ElementarPhilosophie* of Fichte. This influence consists of two specific questions, to which Fichte seems to have to provide an answer: *on the one hand*, the problem of the *evidence* of the validity of the presupposition of philosophy, deriving from Maimon's criticism of Kant "quid facti?"; *on the other*, the question of the *relation* between logic and philosophy, developed in Maimon's "new theory of thinking".
